

Scholar Work: PG training Anesthesiology

Objectives

Throughout this scholar work, the resident should be capable of demonstrating:

1. critical analysis of a medical subject, particularly in the domains relevant to anesthesiology
2. clear and efficient communication on a medical topic

Type of work

This work can be based on a research project, a case-study, a review of the literature on a specific topic.

- The research project can cover basic sciences, clinical medicine, public health, or any other relevant domains (for example medical education).
- The case-studies can cover a clinical case-report, or analysis of an incident or medical error, programs or aspects of programs in public health in relation to anesthesia, the study of a case related to a law or ethical dilemmas.
- A review of the literature could equally concern any question related to healthcare or medicine in general. This review should then be systematic and comprehensive.
- In all cases, the work can be a continuation of a pregraduate master thesis, or included in a broader context such as MD-PhD thesis or PD habilitation.
- It also entitles the candidate to postulate for a Doctorate title if his scholar work fills the criteria of a dissertation as defined by the SIWF/IFSM.
